

Winter Camp Check List

Ready to pack? Wondering what to bring? Due to the atmosphere and nature of winter camp, there will be durations of the program that will be outside. We strongly advise bringing clothes appropriate for the outdoors. (example: snow/water proof apparel, especially if there is snow, and several changes of clothes in the case where something gets wet)

What to Bring

Casual, warm clothes, jeans, winter jacket/pants, gloves, hats

Bathing Suit (If interesting in Polar Plunge)

Sneakers, Boots

Toiletries: Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Hairbrush, Shampoo, Deodorant, Soap, Towels

Bedding, Sleeping Bag, Pillow

Bible, Notepad, Pen or Pencil

Other Suggested Items

Camera

Flashlight

Ice Skates, Snowboard / Skis

Do Not to Bring

No contraband - knives, weapons, etc.
